

RESOLUTION NO 2145

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HERMISTON AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$225,000 FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES TO DESIGN THE 2021 APRON RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Hermiston owns and operates the Hermiston Municipal Airport; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration has deemed the aircraft parking apron to be in "poor" condition due to age; and

WHEREAS, Apron Reconstruction is a project on the approved Airport Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the FAA is prepared to issue a grant for the construction of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hermiston, Oregon that the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to accept a grant not to exceed \$225,000 for engineering services to design the 2021 Apron Reconstruction Project.

EFFECTIVE immediately upon passage.
