

RESOLUTION NO 2149

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HERMISTON AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$70,000 FOR AIRPORT OPERATIONS FROM THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY (CARES) ACT.

WHEREAS, the City of Hermiston owns and operates the Hermiston Municipal Airport; and

WHEREAS, the CARES Act was approved and signed on March 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the CARES Act includes \$10 Billion for the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to help airports with operational expenses; and

WHEREAS, the FAA has been directed to issue \$69,000 to the City of Hermiston before April 30, 2020 to support operational expenses of the Hermiston Municipal Airport.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hermiston, Oregon that the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to apply for and accept a grant not to exceed \$70,000 from the FAA for airport operations.

EFFECTIVE immediately upon passage.
