A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR MUTUAL AID AND INTERAGENCY COOPERATION AMONG LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES LOCATED IN UMATILLA AND MORROW COUNTIES

WHEREAS, law enforcement agencies in Umatilla and Morrow County have operated for many years with an Intergovernmental Agreement for Mutual Aid assistance; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to establish an accepted means to coordinate the effective delivery of mutual aid and mutual assistance between and among their law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to provide mutual aid and mutual assistance to one another at a reasonable cost by eliminating duplication where feasible and making the most efficient use of their resources; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to provide for interagency cooperation between their law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Hermiston City Council is the governing body for the City of Hermiston Police Department;

WHEREAS, under authority of Chapter 190, Oregon Revised Statutes, the parties agree to adopt the Intergovernmental Agreement for Mutual Aid and Interagency Cooperation among Law Enforcement Agencies located in Umatilla and Morrow County, Oregon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hermiston, Oregon as follows:

- 1. The Hermiston chief of police is authorized to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement for Mutual Aid and Interagency Cooperation among Law Enforcement Agencies located in Umatilla and Morrow Counties, to include,
