

**RESOLUTION NO. 2193**

WHEREAS, ongoing residential development along the E Diagonal Blvd corridor has the potential to increase the volume of pedestrian and bicycle trips in the northeast quarter of the city, and

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon has designated specific speeds which may be set at the local level without the need for a speed study conducted by the Oregon Department of Transportation, and

WHEREAS, ORS 811.105 designates that a speed limit of 25 mph is appropriate for residential roads, and

WHEREAS, E Diagonal Blvd between E Ridgeway Ave and NE 10<sup>th</sup> Street is primarily residentially zoned, serves several residential neighborhoods, and serves as the primary route serving Sandstone Middle School and Highland Hills Elementary School, NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERMISTON, OREGON, that it is necessary to protect the health and safety of its citizens through designating a speed limit of 25 miles per hour on E Diagonal Blvd between the intersections of E Ridgeway Ave and NE 10<sup>th</sup> Street.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage as of the date and year set out below.
